


COVID-19 Transaction and Revenue Update



» Approval of a Vehicle Prohibition Order for the identified habitual violator customers

- » Number of prohibited vehicles: 230
- » Total number of unpaid tolls: 236,825
 - Median number of outstanding tolls per vehicle: 990
 - Median unpaid toll balance: \$1,714
 - Median unpaid admin fee balance: \$529

- » Customers will receive Prohibition Order by mail
- » Customers found to be in violation of prohibition are subject to warning, citation with up to \$500 fine and/or vehicle impoundment
